

### **Choice and Affordability Fund**

#### Queensland Catholic Education Commission – Annual Report 2020

#### **Executive Summary**

As part of the Federal Funding reforms announced in September 2018, the Australian Government established the Choice and Affordability Fund (the Fund) to support non-government schools. The Fund is provided under the *Australian Education Act 2013* and commenced in 2020 with an estimated \$1.2 billion to be provided to the non-government school sector over ten years to 2029.

For the Catholic sector, the funding between States and Territories is determined by the National Catholic Education Commission (NCEC). In 2020, the Queensland Catholic sector received a total of \$10.5 million under the fund.

As outlined in the *Choice and Affordability Fund Agreement* between the Australian Government and Queensland Catholic Education Commission (QCEC), the Fund is to be used by Queensland Catholic schools in line with national priorities including:

- Choice and affordability of schools
- Transition assistance
- Special circumstances funding

For Queensland Catholic schools, supporting choice and affordability of schools was the primary focus of the Fund in 2020. Most Catholic school authorities (CSAs) have achieved this by offering fee relief or concession to families facing financial and other hardships. Some CSAs chose to use the funds to help alleviate the impact of rising operating costs and reducing recurrent funding in order to maintain an affordable fee level for their students. All these initiatives have enabled children from vulnerable and disadvantaged families to continue studying at their school of choice.

Other CSAs have allocated the funds to training and other activities aimed at empowering students, supporting student wellbeing, and improving teaching practices. These activities are expected to result in improved student engagement and outcomes.

# Progress against your agreement and/or work plan

In 2020, Queensland Catholic schools expended \$4.2 million of the Fund in addressing the national priorities as prescribed by the Australian Government.

The balance of \$6.3 million has been allocated to activities in future years.

## The distribution of funding

The QCEC distribution of the Fund was based on each school's percentage share of total Australian Government Recurrent Funding as distributed by QCEC to each CSA. This distribution had been committed to, budgeted, and planned for by schools before the announcement of the Regional and Remote Assistance Fund.

The QCEC distribution of the Regional and Remote Assistance Fund will begin from 2021 with the total allocation distributed in full over the nine-year period 2021 to 2029.

QCEC does not administer any centralised initiatives under the Fund. The allocation received in 2020 was fully distributed to the CSAs who have distributed \$4.2 million in 2020 and allocated the remaining \$6.3 million to later year activities. The information in **Attachment A** reflects the amount of the Fund expended by each school or CSA in 2020.
